Other Activities Offered:

Teton Village is a skiers town, and this is a ski club ski trip; so if you want to do something else - go someplace else! However; the town of Jackson Hole is a short (free) shuttle bus ride away. There are interesting shops and classic western restaurants, including the Million Dollar Bar (where all the barstools are made from saddles) and free line dancing lessons every Tuesday night. There is dog sledding at the base of the mountain, and Snowshoeing, X-Country Skiing or snowmobile tours can be arranged in Yellowstone National Park, just 60 miles away. You can also take an afternoon off the slopes and enjoy the well reviewed Solitude Spa services right at the Teton Mountain Inn.
