In 1995 Big Sky added the Lone Peak Tram transporting the courageous to the top of 11,166-foot high Lone Mountain. This 15-person Doppelmayr tram accesses extreme, expert and advanced terrain.

This south facing skiing area has been described as offering expert skiers European-like high, open face skiing, with chutes and couloirs and extreme pitches of more than 50 degrees.

With more than 40 bars and restaurants, shopping, night life, swimming pools, health spa, outdoor Jacuzzis and lots of outdoor activities Big Sky caters to all ages and all tastes.

- Final payment of **\$652** due November 10, 2010.

Cancellation Policy

If you need to cancel, you must provide written notice to the trip leader. The following charges will apply (per person) based upon the date of receipt of written cancellation notice. Every effort will be made to substitute from the waiting list (if there is one) for any cancellations. Cancellation fees will be automatically deducted from any applicable refund. Any questions about the cancellation policy should be directed to your trip leaders. In all cases, cancelling party is subject to re-ticketing fee assessed by airline.
